

Sunbelt Exchange Archiver v4.2

New features:

Archive Web 2.0 new features

- Additional language support. Italian language was added to the list of available localizations.
- Log in using UPN. It is now possible to log on into the ArchiveWeb using user principal name (format: user@domain). No configuration changes needed, this feature is available by default. The old way (format: domain\user) used for logging is still available as well.
- Setting for order of tabs. Users can now change the basic look and feel of the ArchiveWeb by setting the order of main tabs in the left menu. This order is saved per user.
- Preferred mail body. Users can choose what format they prefer by default when viewing archived items in the ArchiveWeb. This option can be found on the Settings tab and is saved per user.
- Public folder permission synchronization enhancement – speed up.

Enterprise Manager changes

- The manager now logs all actions made in the Enterprise Manager console. If Auditing is configured, the configuration, settings, job, addressbook changes, and all other operations create log entries in the auditing dataset.

List of fixes:

- Bugfix: If the superuser account and PF database were on different Exchange servers, Public Folder synchronization was problematic. If the Public Folder server was not synchronized in PAM4Exchange, the permission synchronization was not made. A config key called PUBLICFOLDERSERVERSNAMELIST can now be added to the Synchronization configuration file, telling the name of the PF server. If this setting is done, permissions are synchronized to the superuser server.
- Bugfix: ArchiveWeb. When viewing the list of lost items, just the first 1500 items were shown.
- Bugfix: Installation package. The package allowed entering a username containing illegal characters (. ` ! @ % ^ & * () - + = [] { } | , ; : " < > / ?)
- Bugfix: if the PST folder reading took longer than 10 minutes, no message was imported.
- Bugfix: if the import of a message took longer than 10 minutes, the processing thread was aborted. After this the importer could skip some messages from processing.
- Bugfix: OEM search was not working because one column was not returned in a stored procedure.
- Bugfix: if a PST import service was connecting to the manager service and the client ports were blocked by a firewall, the manager service was not able to answer new client connections until the firewall returned a timeout.
- Bugfix: when the SID in DB was empty during AD mailbox synchronization, the mailbox was marked as deleted.
